The Truro Township Trustees held a regular meeting Thursday, September 3, 2026, at 4:00 pm at Station 161. Present were Trustees Dennis Nicodemus, Toni Kleckley and Pat Mahaffey, Fiscal Officer Natalie Nicodemus, Chief Bryan and Administrator Jason Nicodemus.

The Meeting was called to order with the pledge and roll call.

Regular Meeting

Dennis Nicodemus moved to approve meeting minutes from the August 13 regular meeting. Pat Mahaffey seconded. All in favor.

Asst Chief Bryan:

- 708 runs in August
 - EMS runs 436
 - Fire runs 267
 - Response activity was higher in the month of August due to severe weather and flooding in the Briarcliff area.
- New Medic 162 was placed into service.
- Tomato Festival and National Night out were successful, with strong community engagement.
- Reynoldsburg Police Department will be implementing drones into emergency response operations. These drones may provide useful support to the fire department during certain situations. They should be operational by October.
- Personnel Actions:
 - Chief Bryan asked for a motion to declare a Lieutenant vacancy due to Lt. Lautner retirement effective September 2, 2026.
 - Chief Bryan asked for a motion to promote Walker Mees to the vacant Lieutenant position effective September 3, 2026.
 - Dennis Nicodemus made a motion to declare a Lieutenant vacancy and to promote Walker Mees to the position. Pat Mahaffey seconded. All in favor.

- Chief Bryan asked for a motion to declare three firefighter vacancies due to resignations in the department.
- Dennis Nicodemus made a motion to declare three firefighter vacancies. Toni Kleckley seconded. All in favor.
- Chief Bryan is recommending the hire of Isaac Stockdale, Wyatt Gregory and Alexander Miller to full-time firefighter, pending successful passage of required physicals.
- Dennis Nicodemus made a motion to hire the three candidates pending required physicals. Pat Mahaffey seconded. All in favor.
- Chief Bryan is recommending hiring Joel Ochoa for part-time employment.
- Dennis Nicodemus made a motion to hire Joel Ochoa. Pat Mahaffey seconded. All in favor.
